### Place-based programs on a new sailing classroom

Bring your students out on the water for a transforming experience that will renew enthusiasm for learning and make your curriculum come alive!

The newly launched gundalow *Piscataqua* serves as our floating classroom where students are engaged in onboard, hands-on education while under sail.

Students will explore environmental science and maritime heritage through activities that incorporate concepts of social studies, science, math, art, and language arts. The program also emphasizes problem solving, decision making, critical thinking and working as a team.

The cultural and natural history of the Piscataqua Maritime Region come to life as your students join the crew – helping to set the sail, steer the vessel, and navigate. A quiet period can be adapted to allow for observing, journaling, reading or drawing.

Field trips on the *Piscataqua* include our standard 2.5 hour school program offered mornings and afternoons, or a 4 hour option. Also

available is a half-day Coastal Floating Lab with the UNH Marine Docents that focuses on marine and estuarine science. A licensed captain is in charge and all onboard activities are led by trained educators. Sailing programs can be combined with a concurrent land-based field trip to accommodate larger groups.
