



Materials Boat design and tradition determines the type of wood that will be used for different parts of the boat. This gundalow is made of all local wood grown in the northeastern United States and Nova Scotia, including:

White Oak

rot resistant and strong used for framing, planking, & stump mast



Black Locust

local, shapely, stable, & extremely rot resistant used for skeg, rudder, rails, & trunnels



White Pine

local, serviceable, stable & lightweight used for deck, superstructure, house, hatches, etc.



Hackmatack & Live Oak

rot resistant & shaped correctly used for knees



Spruce

high strength to weight ratio used for yard
